- What does it mean for the ground to be "cursed" because of Adam's sin?
- How does this curse impact humanity's relationship with work and labor? In what ways do we experience the effects of this curse in our daily lives?
- How does the narrative in this passage reveal God's justice and mercy

• In light of Genesis 3:15, how does this verse describe the way God breaks the power of sin?

Next steps

- If Christians are no longer under God's judgment for sin, do our sinful decisions and actions still carry consequences in our day to day life?
- How does knowing Jesus give us both hope for the future and a path through our present 'fallen world'?
