Read

Genesis 6

Observe & reflect

- What is was the trigger or catalyst for God's judgment?
- How does this passage describe the heart of God?

Read

- How was Noah's 'righteousness' demonstrated?

Read

Genesis 9:7-17

Observe & reflect

- What was the promise God made? Why do you think God made this promise?
- Does this mean that God will never judge the world again?

- How do these New Testament passages treat the account of the flood?
- What do they teach us is the enduring lesson of the narrative of Noah and the flood?
